## COUNTRY CLUB FACT SHEET

<b>ESTABLISHED:</b>	1975
<b>LOCATION/ACCESS:</b>	Palm Beach County, Fla., roughly five miles inland from the Atlantic coastline, on the west side of Boca Raton. Juego Way is just off the Florida Turnpike, south of Highway 808 (Glades Road) and north of West Palmetto Park Road.
<b>CLIMATE:</b>	Warm, tropical climate with winter temperatures typically in the 70s and 80s, summers in the high 80s to low 90s.
<b>HISTORY/OVERVIEW:</b>	<p>In 1975, Boca Lago Country Club debuted as the centerpiece of the Boca Lago community, created by Philadelphia real estate entrepreneur Benjamin Frankel.</p> <p>The development was roughly eight years in the making, initiated by reparation of wetlands. Homesites were set along the new golf course and canals. Initially, custom detached homes started at \$355,000.</p>
<b>RENOVATIONS:</b>	<p>Currently a comprehensive enhancement of the entire property is in progress, including a \$3.6-million renovation of the clubhouse, to be completed in late 2018. The facility will showcase upgraded dining areas and pool complex, as well as all-new outdoor dining and gathering spaces.</p> <p>The 27-hole golf course, originally built in 1975 by Robert Von Hagge and Bruce Devlin, also is undergoing a complete \$5.5 million renovation guided by architect Jan Bel Jan. The three nines will be ready for play in November 2018.</p>
<b>LIFESTYLE:</b>	<p>Nestled among 250 pristine acres of wonderfully natural Florida landscape, which includes more than 50 acres of mirrored lakes, Boca Lago offers a relaxed private-club environment and premier facilities designed for the outdoor lifestyle that south Florida offers like no other place in the U.S.</p> <p>Featuring magnificent golf, an award-winning tennis complex, fine dining, and casual cuisine, Boca Lago is a premier club in Boca Raton, featuring competitively priced Membership programs, no requirement to reside on property to be a member and an easily accessible location.</p>

**GOLF:**

27 holes comprised of three nines. Greens, bunkering, and teeing grounds redesigned in 2018. Multiple tees give numerous options for playing each hole, with the lakes and tree lined fairways playing a pivotal role in the character of all three nines.

Boca Lago has been a member of the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program since 1993. Carts available; walking is encouraged.

Expansive practice facilities include full-swing space, a superior practice putting area and dedicated short-game area, plus two practice holes. PGA Professional instruction, including private lessons and group clinics, and complete club-fitting services are available. The Club is committed to PGA Grow the Game Initiatives and is forming a PGA Junior League Team in 2019.

**East Course** Par 36 plays from 3,374 to 2,104 yards

**West Course** Par 35 plays from 2,955 to 1,742 yards

**South Course** Par 36 plays 3,212 to 2,060 yards

**FITNESS:**

Recently renovated with new resistance and aerobic equipment, a free-weight room, stretching area, state-of-the-art blood pressure measurement station, flat screen televisions. Dry saunas located in both the men's and women's locker rooms.

On-site fitness staff available during open hours, as are personal training services. Group fitness activities include aerobics, yoga, tai chi, and body sculpting.

**SWIMMING:**

Olympic-size swimming pool and separate lap pool are both heated in the winter season for year-round enjoyment.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:**

Boca Lago has a proud history of hosting prestigious charity and corporate golf tournaments. The courses are suited for competition, with facilities ideal for staging pre- and post-tournament activities.

The club's spacious dining room is ideal for banquets and wedding receptions. Recently reconfigured and renovated, the dining room has been opened up to accommodate seating for up to 375 guests, including a dance floor and stage. Floor-to-ceiling windows present elevated views of the golf course and lake on the east side of the 250-acre property.

**TENNIS:**

Ranked among the top five tennis clubs in Boca Raton. Under the direction of Rick Macci, one of the leading professionals in the country, the "club within a club" features 16 Har-Tru courts, four quick-dry, lighted hard courts.

The complex includes a separate tennis clubhouse with a Center Court Café and Pro Shop, locker rooms and showers, as well as a lap pool.

The Rick Macci Tennis Academy is considered one of the game's premier learning environments, with a maximum capacity of 40 students.

Members have access to 1-on-1 private lessons with Macci, as well as adult team and private group workouts at preferred pricing.

**MEMBERSHIPS:**

Boca Lago Country Club offers a variety of competitive equity, non-proprietary full, and seasonal golf or tennis/social memberships in a number of categories, including single, family, executive junior, and corporate

The Club also features a summer golf membership.

**RESIDENTIAL:**

Pulte Homes has unveiled Boca Flores, a 55+ active adult community located adjacent to the tennis club. The community, which offers three different floorplans, features membership options to the Boca Lago Country Club. Home prices start at \$375,900.
