RENOVATION: The 2018 redevelopment of the South, East, and West nines

includes redesigned greens, repositioned and re-contoured bunkers in the fairways and around greens, as well as reshaped

and rearranged teeing grounds.

The renovation incorporates the best elements of the original course design with a revitalized approach to strategy and

playability from each tee. There are multiple choices of how to play each hole, with the lakes and tree lined fairways still playing a pivotal role in the character of all three nines.

The golf course infrastructure has also been modernized with new irrigation and pump systems installed, fairway drainage enhanced, complete re-grassing tees through greens and cart

paths refreshed or removed.
