RENOVATION:	The 2018 redevelopment of the South, East, and West nines includes redesigned greens, repositioned and re-contoured bunkers in the fairways and around greens, as well as reshaped and rearranged teeing grounds.				

The renovation incorporates the best elements of the original course design with a revitalized approach to strategy and

playability from each tee. There are multiple choices of how to play each hole, with the lakes and tree lined fairways still playing a pivotal role in the character of all three nines.

The golf course infrastructure has also been modernized with new irrigation and pump systems installed, fairway drainage enhanced, complete re-grassing tees through greens and cart paths refreshed or removed.

ENVIRONMENT:	Boca Lago has been a member of the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program since 1993.
CARTS/WALKING:	Carts available/walking encouraged
PRACTICE FACILITY:	Expansion of the practice facilities includes more full-swing space, three practice putting areas and a dedicated short-game area, as well as two practice holes that can be played in multiple ways. The practice areas sport similar grass types as the golf course.
INSTRUCTION:	Programs for all ages and skill levels are offered by PGA Professionals through a selection of private and group lessons or clinics to develop skills in the short game, long game, and course management skills. Club fitting services available. The Club is forming a PGA Junior League Team in 2019.
LOCKER ROOMS:	Men's and women's locker rooms serve golf, fitness, swimming, and tennis facilities.
SPECIAL EVENTS:	Boca Lago Country Club has a proud history of hosting prestigious charitable and corporate golf tournaments. The courses are suited for competition, with facilities ideal for staging pre- and post-tournament activities, banquets, and award ceremonies.
